

# Conjunctive Adverbs

Conjunctive adverbs connect two independent clauses

and show a relationship between the two clauses.

They help create a transition to improve the flow of sentences.

## Some examples of conjunctive adverbs

<u>Addition or another fact</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• also</li><li>• additionally</li><li>• again</li><li>• besides</li><li>• finally</li><li>• furthermore</li><li>• moreover</li><li>• plus</li></ul>	<u>Contrast or change of idea</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• anyways</li><li>• however</li><li>• instead</li><li>• nevertheless</li><li>• otherwise</li><li>• contrarily</li><li>• conversely</li><li>• nonetheless</li><li>• rather</li></ul>	<u>Time</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• meanwhile</li><li>• next</li><li>• then</li><li>• now</li><li>• thereafter</li><li>• before</li><li>• since</li><li>• lately</li><li>• first. second...</li><li>• eventually</li></ul>
