

# Singular and Plural Nouns

- Singular noun means **ONE** person, place, thing, or an idea.
- Plural noun means **MORE than** one person, place, thing, or an idea.

Usually, you can add "s" to the singular noun to make it plural. Based on the spelling of the singular noun, the rules may change.
