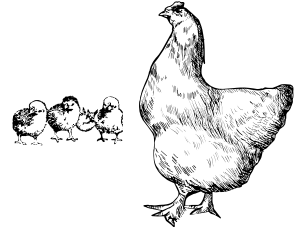


# Singular and Plural Nouns
