Simple verb tense is known as the three basic tenses: past, present, and future.

Verb tense	Rules	Examples
Simple past tense	Add “~ed” to the verb	They walk ---> They walked
Simple present tense	If the subject is singular, add “~s, ~es” to the verb	She walks They walk
Simple future tense	Add “will” before the verb	He will walk
